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# Next Level

The Southern Rhône sets a new benchmark in 2016, while the North also excels

When I first tasted the 2016 reds from the Southern Rhône, I realized immediately I needed to do one thing: Taste them again. That was back in the summer of 2017, as I visited numerous top estates in the region, tasting from barrel. I was struck by how vividly ripe the wines were, yet also detailed and fresh.

Comparing them to other benchmark vintages, they had the tannic spine of 2010 and 2005, the racy length and cut of 2011 and 2001, and the ripe fruit of 2015 and 2009. But I had never seen all of these characteristics combined in a single vintage. Simply put, I hadn't tasted wines before that were so rich and electric at the same time.

I wasn't the only one who suspected something truly special was in the making. One of the vintners visited was Yannick Saunier, whose Châteauneuf-du-Pape cuvées have established a new paradigm for the appellation. "2016 is something totally new," he told me at the time. "We don't have words for it yet. There is something unusual between the color and the tannins. When you pour the wine and see the color, it's so dark. But then the wine is so fresh, the tannins so integrated. We don't know why, but it's doing its thing."

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**88 Domaine Rièvre Cadène Côtes du Roussillon**

**Via Augusta 2017 \$18** Good energy encases the crushed strawberry and tangy raspberry flavors of this medium- to full-bodied red, with fresh acidity and supple tannins lending structure to the white pepper, mineral and floral details on the earth-tinged finish. Grenache and Syrah. Drink now through 2024. 1,250 cases made.—G.S.

**88 Vignobles Vergnes Limoux Château Martinolles Garriguet Vieilles Vignes 2016 \$20**

A graphite undertone accents the focused currant and black cherry flavors of this full-bodied red, with elements of mocha, licorice and dried herb casting into the spicy finish. Supple tannins. Merlot, Syrah and Cabernet Sauvignon. Drink now through 2024. 2,250 cases made.—G.S.

**87 Georges Duboeuf Pinot Noir Pays d'Oc 2017**

**\$12** Juicy and bright, featuring flavors of wild cherry and currant mixed together with spice, dried herb and mineral. Light-bodied and fresh, offering tangy acidity and modest tannins. Drink now through 2020. 2,500 cases made.—G.S.

**87 Domaine Força Réal Côtes du Roussillon-Villages Mas de la Garrigue 2016 \$19**

A concentrated and focused red, with a solid structure framing the blackberry compote, espresso and currant paste flavors. Grilled herbs and hot stone elements mark the firm finish. Grenache, Syrah and Carignan. Drink now through 2021. 7,000 cases made.—G.S.

**86 Georges Duboeuf Cabernet Sauvignon Pays d'Oc 2017 \$12**

A fresh, medium-bodied red, featuring currant and boysenberry fruit detailed with spice and tangy elements. Moderate tannins frame the herb-laced finish. Drink now through 2019. 1,500 cases made.—G.S.

**86 Georges Duboeuf Merlot Pays d'Oc 2017 \$12**

Fresh and medium-bodied, with ripe currant and crushed strawberry notes that are spiced and herb-tinged. Offers moderate, supple tannins. Drink now through 2020. 750 cases made.—G.S.

**85 Georges Duboeuf Chardonnay Pays d'Oc 2017 \$12**

Light- to medium-bodied and lightly spiced, with a plump profile offering apple and lemon notes. Creamy finish. Drink now. 1,500 cases made.—G.S.

**FRANCE****Rhône / Châteauneuf-du-Pape****99 Domaine St.-Préfert Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**Collection Charles Giraud 2016 \$105** This has a large core of well-steeped plum, blackberry puree and warm cassis flavors, inlaid liberally with ganache, graphite and Turkish coffee notes. There's a wide swath of tobacco and roasted alder detail through the finish, matched by racy acidity for balancing focus. This is very deep and very long, capturing the intense yet fresh fruit feel of the vintage to a T. Best from 2020 through 2040. 660 cases made.—J.M.

**97 Henri Bonneau & Fils Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**Réserve des Célestins 2012 \$375** This defines old school, with savory detail and notes of roasted chestnut, fresh tobacco leaf, cedar and brick dust leading off, backed by a core of currant, cherry and plum fruit flavors that is lightly dried yet nonetheless fresh and racy in feel. Singed juniper and bay leaf hints score the finish. Likely to hold just like this for some time. Best from 2020 through 2040. 400 cases made.—J.M.

**97 Domaine St.-Préfert Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**Auguste Favier Réserve 2016 \$62** This is beautifully rendered, with a core of focused red currant, plum and raspberry coulis flavors that stretches out nicely while flecks of tobacco, bergamot, and singed sandalwood weave around. A bolt of iron detail shows through the finish, with a light echo of worn leather. Well-built, showing ample energy in reserve. Best from 2020 through 2040. 1,400 cases made.—J.M.

**96 Domaine La Barroche Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**Pure 2015 \$100** This has the ripe profile of the vintage, pulling blood orange, damson plum, cherry and red currant preserve flavors together and supporting them with enticing apple wood, dried tobacco, savory and sanguine notes before letting them sail through the finish on a long iron accent. Built for the cellar. Best from 2020 through 2040. 50 cases imported.—J.M.

**96 Domaine de Beaurenard Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**Bolsenard 2016 \$85** Solidly built, with a sappy core of kirsch, blackberry paste and red licorice flavors tightly coiled together and backed by roasted apple wood, warm stone and tobacco leaf notes through the finish. The beautiful fruit should develop nicely with extended cellaring, as this has serious grip and drive. Best from 2020 through 2040. 800 cases made.—J.M.

**96 Lucien & André Brunel Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**Les Cailloux Cuvée Centenaire 2015 \$230** Ripe and solid, with a core of warm fig, fruitcake, mulled plum and roasted alder notes rolled together, carried by a lively mineral streak and backed by sanguine, bergamot and savory flashes on the finish. This has lots of character, showing excellent range and cut through the finish. Best from 2020 through 2040. 50 cases imported.—J.M.

**96 Le Clos du Caillou Châteauneuf-du-Pape La**

**Réserve 2016 \$175** This has the ripe, pure and racy profile of the vintage, sporting a long beam of raspberry, plum and cherry pâte de fruit flavors scored with floral, incense and tea notes along the way. Fresh acidity lets the elements ripple nicely through the finish. A beauty. Best from 2020 through 2040. 470 cases made.—J.M.

**96 Domaine Ferrando Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**Colombis 2016 \$90** This is warm and very alluring, featuring steeped plum, blackberry and fig fruit flavors forming the core, underscored with ganache, roasted alder and smoldering tobacco notes. The alder edge pierces the finish, adding length and drive, while mouthwatering acidity ripples all around. Best from 2020 through 2035. 750 cases made.—J.M.

**96 Domaine de la Mordorée Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**La Reine des Bois 2016 \$140** A strapping, richly layered wine, teeming with blackberry, black currant and boysenberry paste flavors wrapped in a lively black licorice note. Stays juicy and energetic throughout, with light bramble and graphite nuances checking in on the very long and powerfully built finish. Best from 2020 through 2040. 90 cases imported.—J.M.

**96 Rotem & Mounir Saouma Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**Omnia 2015 \$700** This is sublime, with beguiling rooibos tea, blood orange and sandalwood aromas out front followed by a long and silky display of lightly mulled cherry, damson plum and raspberry fruit flavors. Light shiso leaf and sanguine notes lace up the finish while the fruit echoes admirably. Best from 2020 through 2040. 50 cases imported.—J.M.

**96 Domaine St.-Préfert Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**White Cuvée Spéciale Vieilles Clairettes 2016 \$322/1.5L** Distinctive, with a well of grapefruit oil, lemon curd, meringue, white peach, jasmine and quinine notes all flowing in lockstep and backed by a finish that has both languid and racy aspects as this lingers. Only bottled in magnum. Best from 2019 through 2025. 66 cases made.—J.M.

**95 Domaine de Cristia Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**Vieilles Vignes 2016 \$95** Ripe, but bright and fresh, with a lively mix of raspberry, red currant and bitter plum coulis flavors streaming in, pulling light tea, singed sandalwood and anise notes along. Shows lovely detail and well-embedded acidity through the finish. Drink now through 2035. 600 cases made.—J.M.

**95 Rotem & Mounir Saouma Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**Arioso 2014 \$200** Alluring, with blood orange, raspberry and bergamot notes that glide through on silky but persistent tannins, while black tea, dried anise and

incense notes weave in and around them. A refined mineral echo pierces the otherwise very seductive finish, making for an intriguing contrast. An impressive effort for the vintage. Drink now through 2035. 12 cases imported.—J.M.

**95 Château Sixtine Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**2016 \$70** Sappy and intense, with a terrific beam of dark plum, boysenberry and blackberry fruit. The long finish shows a gorgeous graphite underpinning while flashes of Turkish coffee, licorice snap and roasted apple wood fill in. Great energy. Best from 2020 through 2040. 2,500 cases made.—J.M.

**95 Le Vieux Donjon Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**2016 \$70** This offers a blitz of bay leaf and juniper notes out front, followed by a racy and tightly coiled core of red and black currant, damson plum and cherry fruit flavors. Lots of brisk iron and garrigue accents rifle through the finish. Clear, precise and streamlined, this should age wonderfully. Best from 2020 through 2040. 7,000 cases made.—J.M.

**94 Domaine La Barroche Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**2015 \$60** Ripe and warm in feel, featuring steeped plum and red currant fruit wrapped with melted red licorice, apple wood and bay leaf notes. The focused finish has ample spine, with a strong bolt of iron at the end. Best from 2020 through 2035. 500 cases imported.—J.M.

**94 Domaine de Cristia Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**Renaissance 2016 \$75** Warm and inviting, with waves of dark plum, cassis and blackberry puree pouring forth, inlaid with light ganache and graphite threads. The plush and velvety feel through the finish puts this squarely in the hedonist camp. Best from 2020 through 2035. 600 cases made.—J.M.

**94 Vignobles Diffonty Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**Cuvée du Vatican 2016 \$40** Solid, with a core of steeped raspberry, blackberry and plum fruit, laced with lavender, tobacco and singed chestnut hints. The grippy finish lets the fruit pump through while showing a tug of tarry earth. Best from 2020 through 2035. 2,500 cases made.—J.M.

**94 Domaine de la Mordorée Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**La Reine des Bois 2015 \$140** Dark and winey, featuring ripe waves of warm, steeped fig, boysenberry and plum fruit rolling through, inlaid with roasted apple wood, tobacco and dark earth details. Displays heft through the finish, with a slightly toothy plum skin edge, but the density and drive is there. Best from 2020 through 2035. 600 cases made.—J.M.

**94 Château Sixtine Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**2015 \$70** Made in a slightly rugged style, with bramble and tobacco notes framing a core of steeped cherry, plum and red currant fruit flavors. Brick dust and singed cedar accents score the finish, while the fruit pumps through. Rock-solid. Best from 2020 through 2040. 1,300 cases made.—J.M.

**94 Domaine de la Solitude Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**Cornelia Constanza 2016 \$150** This features a core of intense raspberry and boysenberry reduction notes, liberally infused with anise hints and laced with mouthwatering black tea and mineral accents, all while staying silky and refined from start to finish. Best from 2019 through 2032. 500 cases made.—J.M.

**94 St.-Cosme Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**2015 \$55** A direct, focused, slightly taut style, with a good dose of singed cedar and alder framing the core of red currant, plum and bitter cherry pasté flavors. Lots of bay leaf, rosemary and sanguine accents fill in on the finish, which keeps a cedar edge. For fans of the old-school style. Best from 2020 through 2035. 1,000 cases made.—J.M.

**93 Domaine de Beaurenard Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

**2016 \$55** Nicely packed, with raspberry and plum compote flavors at the core, liberally lined with singed alder, tobacco and warm brick accents. The finish has a grippy edge, but this red stays fresh and driven overall. Best from 2020 through 2030. 6,000 cases made.—J.M.

**93** François Villard St.-Joseph White Fruit d'Avilleran 2016 \$30 This has a plump and rich core of lemon curd, yellow apple and Cavaillon melon flavors, but there's an inner brightness and purity, with a light floral element gilding through the finish. Very enticing. Drink now through 2020. 787 cases made.—J.M.

**92** Pierre & Jérôme Coursodon St.-Joseph White Silice 2017 \$49 Ripe and pure, with a beam of pear, green plum, yellow apple and melon flavors streaming through, maintaining focus and showing detail to the honeysuckle- and shortbread-tinged finish. Marianne. Drink now through 2023. 550 cases made.—J.M.

**92** Delas St.-Joseph White Les Challeys 2017 \$18 Deliciously pure, brimming with pear, yellow apple, star fruit and white peach flavors, gilded gently with honeysuckle and chamomile accents on the finish. Has weight but stays very fresh. Roussanne. Drink now through 2023. 533 cases made.—J.M.

**92** Bernard Grima St.-Joseph White 2016 \$52 Plump and open in feel, with creamed melon, pear and yellow apple fruit flavors lined with honeysuckle and verbena notes. Offers a gentle, caressing finish. Drink now through 2020. 800 cases made.—J.M.

**92** E. Guigal St.-Joseph White 2016 \$35 Bright, with lots of honeysuckle and orange blossom notes out front, backed by fresh yellow apple and white peach flavors. Shows a flash of mirabelle plum on the finish. Marsanne and Roussanne. Drink now through 2023. 3,333 cases made.—J.M.

**92** Pierre-Jean Villa St.-Joseph White Saut de l'Ange 2016 \$68 The creamed pear and melon fruit is contrasted by lemon shortbread and yellow apple gelée flavors. Light verbena and honeysuckle notes stitch the finish, which ends with a kiss of sweetened butter. Roussanne. Drink now through 2020. 330 cases made.—J.M.

**91** Yves Cuilleron St.-Joseph White Lyseras 2016 \$32 Juicy and open in feel, with a mix of apricot, tangerine and yellow apple fruit flavors mixed with lemon shortbread and verbena notes. Marsanne and Roussanne. Drink now through 2021. 1,625 cases made.—J.M.

## FRANCE

### Rhône / Other Red

**93** Montirius Vacqueyras Le Clos 2016 \$30 Quite ripe, with mouthfilling boysenberry and blackberry confiture notes that show good energy throughout, carried by anise, bramble and apple wood accents through the finish. This will have lots of fans for sure. Best from 2019 through 2024. 1,416 cases made.—J.M.

**92** Domaine de Beaurenard Rasteau Les Argiles Bleues 2016 \$38 Warm and lush waves of raspberry, blackberry and boysenberry compote roll through, laced with graphite and cocoa details and backed by an echo of singed wood on the finish. Drink now through 2022. 500 cases made.—J.M.

**92** Domaine La Bouïssiere Vacqueyras 2016 \$40 Juicy, with a good core of raspberry and boysenberry pâte de fruit flavors. A light brambly edge adds energy through the finish. Pure, with the ripe and fresh profile of the vintage in spades. Drink now through 2020. 75 cases imported.—J.M.

**92** Chêne Bleu Ventoux Abéard 2010 \$85 Ripe and enticing, offering layers of fig, dark currant and blackberry fruit that are well-steeped but still detailed, woven with notes of anise, warm tobacco and roasted alder. Delivers a broad feel on the finish, with the wood playing a prominent role. Very solid. Grenache and Syrah. Drink now through 2022. 75 cases imported.—J.M.

**92** Domaine de la Mordorée Lirac La Reine des Bois 2016 \$43 A core of steeped raspberry and plum fruit is inlaid with singed apple wood, melted licorice and charcoal hints, giving this good range and contrast. The long finish is tightly focused and shows a light mineral echo. Grenache, Mourvèdre and Syrah. Drink now through 2021. 200 cases imported.—J.M.

**91** Domaine de la Mordorée Lirac La Dame Rousse 2016 \$23 Enticingly ripe, with dense raspberry and blackberry paste flavors forming the core while light anise, sweet spice and toast notes fill in around it. A licorice edge takes center stage through the finish. Drink now through 2021. 2,300 cases made.—J.M.

**91** Domaine Le Sang des Cailloux Vacqueyras Cuvée Floureto 2016 \$34 Juicy and fresh, with a ball of cassis and bitter plum fruit leading the way, followed by light mesquite and tobacco notes. The ripe finish has good energy. Drink now through 2020. 600 cases imported.—J.M.

**90** Brotte Cairanne Domaine Grosset 2016 \$18 Focused and fresh, with a graphite beam carrying flavors of cherry, plum and raspberry purée along. Light tea and sandalwood accents add perfume through the finish. Drink now through 2021. 2,780 cases made.—J.M.

**90** Domaine Brusset Cairanne Les Travers 2016 \$21 Lush, with a core of fig and boysenberry confiture rolling through, flecked with licorice, warm fruitcake and cocoa accents. Fruit-driven but with enough spine and definition for balance. For the hedonist crowd. Drink now through 2020. 2,400 cases made.—J.M.

**90** Domaine Brusset Ventoux Les Boudalles 2017 \$13 Pure and refined, with a gentle breeze of unadorned cherry, red currant, violet and mineral notes gliding through on a silky structure. Charming and delightful. Drink now through 2020. 700 cases made.—J.M.

**89** Brotte Cairanne Crédation Grosset 2016 \$15 Dark cherry and red currant fruit is melded with notes of melted licorice and singed vanilla, backed by a lingering tobacco hint on the finish. Offers a good graphite spine. Drink now through 2020. 10,500 cases made.—J.M.

**89** Château de Montfaucon Lirac 2016 \$78 Gentle-edged, with fresh plum and black cherry fruit that glides through while light sandalwood, blood orange and tobacco notes chime in on the finish. Drink now through 2019. 1,700 cases made.—J.M.

**89** Château de Montfaucon Lirac Baron Louis 2015 \$23 Dark and winey, featuring melted licorice, roasted alder, steeped plum and tobacco leaf notes rolled together. Offers a grippy edge, with the alder element lingering longest, leaving a lightly chewy feel. Drink now through 2020. 3,475 cases made.—J.M.

**89** Domaine de Triennes Méditerranée St.-Auguste 2015 \$20 Ripe and fleshy, with singed alder notes around steeped cherry and plum fruit, backed by light leather and pepper accents. Shows more guts than charm, but a solid pick for backyard grilling. Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. Drink now through 2020. 4,000 cases made.—J.M.

**87** André Brunel Grenache Vin de Pays de Vaucluse 2016 \$11 Bright and fun, with breezy raspberry and pomegranate fruit lined with light savory and tea accents. Reveals a flash of dusty tannins. Drink now. 1,500 cases imported.—J.M.

**87** Delas Ventoux 2017 \$12 Fresh and silky in feel, with pretty anise and tea hints inlaid into a core of gently steeped red currant and plum fruit. The fine-grained structure lets the finish linger prettily. Drink now through 2020. 16,667 cases made.—J.M.

**87** La Vieille Ferme Vin de France 2017 \$11 This offers a bright blast of plum fruit laced with violet notes. Silky through the finish. Carignan, Cinsault, Grenache and Syrah. Drink now. 140,000 cases imported.—J.M.
